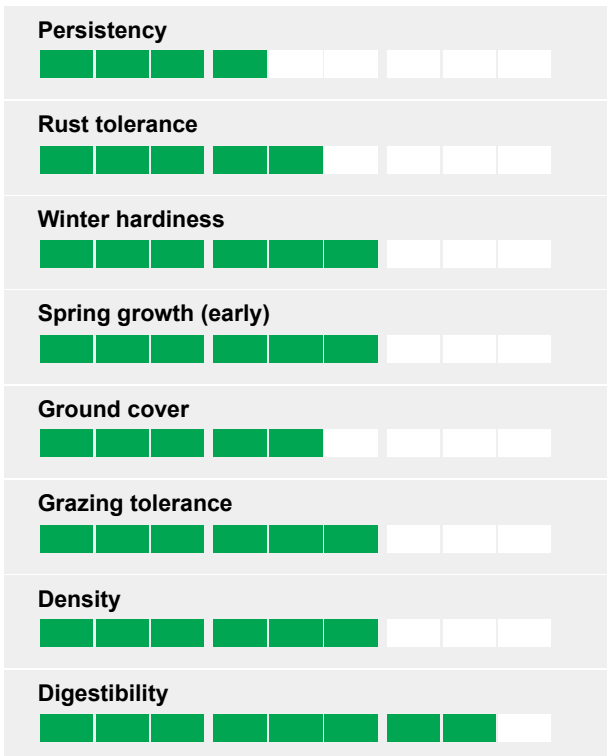




Italian ryegrass type

- Very high yield
- High feeding value
- Good regrowth after cutting
- Quicker recovery after stress
- Late heading type of festulolium

Ratings



Use

Replacement of Italian ryegrass and hybrid ryegrass in silage and aftermath grazing mixtures.

Yield

Dry matter yield similar to Italian ryegrass and higher than hybrid ryegrass in the first two years after sowing.

Stress and Drought Tolerance

More tolerant to drought than Italian or hybrid ryegrass.

Persistence

Similar to hybrid ryegrass but better than Italian ryegrass.

Growth Habit

Almost identical to Italian ryegrass with early spring growth and very quick aftercut recovery.

Forage quality

Due to its late ear emergence, the feeding value and energy content of PERSEUS are very high.

High yield in Danish trials 1st and 2nd year
