



This New Zealand bred cultivar has exceptional shoot density and a high tolerance to close mown wear, helping to prevent the spread of *Poa annua*. Manor also has excellent tolerance to fusarium. An ideal alternative to a fescue for inland courses wishing to reduce *Poa annua* and improve green speed.
